Joseph was born in New York, N.Y., on Aug. 18, 1994. He graduated Park City High School in 2012 after relocating from Cold Spring Harbor, N.Y., in 2010. His transition to Park City was seamless. He earned a WUE scholarship and began attending MSU in Bozeman where he had begun his third year studying engineering. He had recently returned from a semester abroad at the University of Canterbury in Christchurch, New Zealand, traveling through Fiji and Thailand.

Joseph was the quintessential free spirit. Doing as he pleased while also pleasing others. His love for the outdoors is legendary amongst his peers. He could always be found skiing, dirt biking, camping, hiking or surfing. He never let the sun set on a beautiful day without thoroughly engaging in the present.

Music was another passion. A self-taught guitar player, he could often be found playing or listening to classic music from another era. Had he had his way he would have come of age in 1969 in Haight-Ashbury.
